We provide EIABA to children between the ages of 2-6 years old with behavioral, social, and academic deficits. Our focus is to increase independence for individuals with developmental and intellectual disabilities by providing them with the appropriate tools to teach socially-appropriate skills and create autonomy.

EARLY INTERVENTION

ABA

Our in clinic Early Intervention ABA program is a full time* program ideal for young learners from 2-6 years of age. We focus on preparing our children for success when they enter an Elementary School environment. We teach communication, social, play, daily living, and academic skills. We often use the Verbal Behavior Milestone and Placement Program (VBMAPP) to identify client deficits and create individualized program goals.

We offer a naturalistic and play-focused approach to teaching our children.

ABA is beneficial for individuals with developmental and intellectual disabilities such as Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), ADD/ADHD, Global Developmental Delay, and much more. Our programs can address:

- communication deficits
- play skills
- imitation
- academic skills
- toilet training
- daily living skills such as dressing, brushing teeth, and bathing

- safety skills
- task completion
- transition skills
- feeding deficits
- sleep concerns
 - aggressive behaviors
- stereotypic behaviors




PRIVATE CONSULTING


We offer private behavioral consulting virtually or in person for families.
